

Beta Comments

The Population Finder program is currently in the Beta phase. Please expect changes as the Bioinformatics team responds to user feedback. You will find the answers to questions in the <u>FAQ</u>.

Most Population Finder results are clear and unambiguous, but a small percentage of results may fall into one of the two categories below.

What if the total percent does not add up to 100%?

A very small amount of your DNA matches other populations. The amount of matching DNA is too small to report the matching population with confidence because the similarity with your DNA may be coincidental and falls well within the margin of error. More info.

What does it mean if the error is very high?

If you have a high margin of error (Example: +/-15%) then the populations you are matching are very similar to one another. In this case, we cannot distinguish as clearly between the populations, and we are less confident that some proportion of your DNA came from one population rather than the other. This does not affect our ability to predict the continent you are from, but does affect our prediction of what proportion of your ancestry is from the continents listed. More info.
